### **EFRAG – European Commission Outreach event on the Future Agenda of the IASB**

**25 November 2011 in Brussels**

EFRAG and the European Commission invite you to participate in a European outreach event, the purpose of which is to gather input to help the IASB in the determination of its future agenda and priority setting for the development of amended and new standards.

In July of this year the IASB put out a consultation paper on this subject asking for views from constituents and interested parties. The IASB believes that an extensive due process in this respect is necessary to ensure that its future agenda meets with needs perceived in practice. EFRAG issued its Draft Comment Letter on 11 August with a deadline for comment of 15 November.
